RallySafe Tablet Quick Reference

- It can be helpful to review the interactive tutorial at https://rallysafe.com.au/training immediately before each event.
- RallySafe **unit** time is the official time, a small 'float' in the tablets isn't critical.
- Start up Race Commander software if not already started.
- Confirm the event is correct
- Select 'role' (Time control, start, finish)
- Controls will be named based on the stage they are or follow, in order:
 - TC2 would be ATC for stage 2, TC3 is ATC for stage 3, etc.
 - As an example, if a service follows stage 3, it will be as follows:
 - Service in: TC3A
 - Service out/RGC in: TC3B
 - RGC out: TC3C
- Install Radio dongle when the first course opening car arrives. Remove after the stage running.
- 000 check time against unit. Sync with 000 or 00 if needed
 - Manual > Synch time > 000 (or unit number)>Synch Time
 - Look for confirmation in white window
- Keep tablets dry, moisture on the screens will cause issues
- Radios have excellent range, tablets can be used from inside cars
- Stop Control can re-order the data fields by dragging the headers so that the finish time is next to the car number.
- Unplug radios and put tablets to sleep between active stages or during downtime. Press the button at the top RH to put the tablet to sleep or wake up.
- Charge tablets during downtimes if possible with either the car charger or battery pack.
- If the tablets aren't sending times to the cars, confirm the antennae connections on the radio dongle are tight and try unplugging the radio and plugging it back in. If that doesn't work, try restarting the system.

Kano - General Tablet Information

- The tablets will have two login options when first turned on. Choose "Control Volunteer". No password is necessary.
- To turn on the tablet hold the top RH button. Press the same button to turn off the screen or wake it up. When the tablet turns on, you will see the lights in the back turn on.
- Use the keyboard stand if needed, but isn't necessary. It also has the tracking pad for the mouse usage, though it is a touchscreen.
- Make sure to practice the procedures with the Course Opening Cars!
